- Lunenburg Landfill, Lunenburg, Va.

"The *Gifting of the Turkeys* celebration is our way of saying thank you to local residents for their commitment to a clean and healthy environment and to extend our appreciation to our facilities' host communities for their support of the vital disposal services we provide throughout the year."

Within the four U.S. states which serve as home to Meridian Waste landfills, more than 100 turkeys were delivered to neighbors equating to over 1,400 lbs. of the holiday favorite.
