City of Oakland Collection Guidelines

Collection Day: Fridays (beginning February 2, 2024)

Set Out Time: Place carts curbside the night before or no later than **6:30 AM** on Friday to ensure service.

Materials: All waste materials must be INSIDE the provided cart (i.e., garbage in the garbage cart, recycling in the recycling cart). Items placed outside the cart will NOT be collected. (An extra 95-gallon cart may be requested for an additional fee.) To help contain litter, please bag waste before placing it in the garbage cart. Do NOT bag recycling.

Weight Limits: Carts CANNOT exceed sixty (60) lb. each.


Holiday Schedule

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed until Saturday. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the collection schedule will NOT be affected.

Holidays Observed: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Cart Placement

Carts MUST be LESS THAN three (3) ft. from the curb and MUST be AT LEAST three (3) ft. away from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers).





Garbage

- Collected weekly
- 95-gallon Meridian Waste cart.
- Only the contents within the trash cart are collected; no materials left outside the cart will be collected.
- Additional carts available for service fee of \$30 per annum for each additional cart to be paid by resident.
- Materials Accepted: Containerized, non-hazardous municipal solid waste.

Recycling

- Collected weekly
- 65-gallon Meridian Waste cart.
- Only the contents within the recycling cart are collected; no materials left outside the cart will be collected.
- Additional carts available for service fee of \$30 per annum for each additional cart to be paid by resident.
- NO plastic bags, plastic films, or construction materials.
 Do NOT bag recyclable materials.

Yard Waste

- Collected weekly
- Contractor-approved rolling container, such as a repurposed Oakland branded 65-gallon recycle container, or biodegradable paper bags or bundles.
 Upon resident request, Meridian will provide one 95- or 65-gallon rolling cart at no additional charge.
- Materials Accepted: Leaves, grass, limbs and branches (bundled) less than 4' in length or 6" in diameter.
- Weight Limit: 60 lb. per can, bag or bundle.
- Quantity Limits: Combined maximum of ten (10) bags (biodegradable paper), bundles (tie with natural fiber twine), and carts per week, no more than 60 lb. each. Bundled stacks of limbs and brush must be less than 18" in diameter and 4' in length.
- Additional carts available for service fee of \$30 per annum for each additional cart to be paid by resident.

Bulky Waste

- One item per week at no cost and must be scheduled in advance. Additional items are \$25 per item paid by resident.
- Call Customer Care to schedule at (314) 291-3131.
- Materials Accepted: Large items like toilets, sinks, mattresses, carpet, furniture, large toys, bicycles and other similar items.
- Weight Limit: 60 lb.

White Goods

- Call to schedule. Cost \$35 per item paid by resident.
- Materials Accepted: Stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, etc.
- Weight Limit: Safe for two people to pick up.

NO - Empty Hazardous Material Containers

NO — Electronic Waste: Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens

NO - Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids

NO - Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids

NO - Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste

NO - Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts

NO - Automobile Bodies
